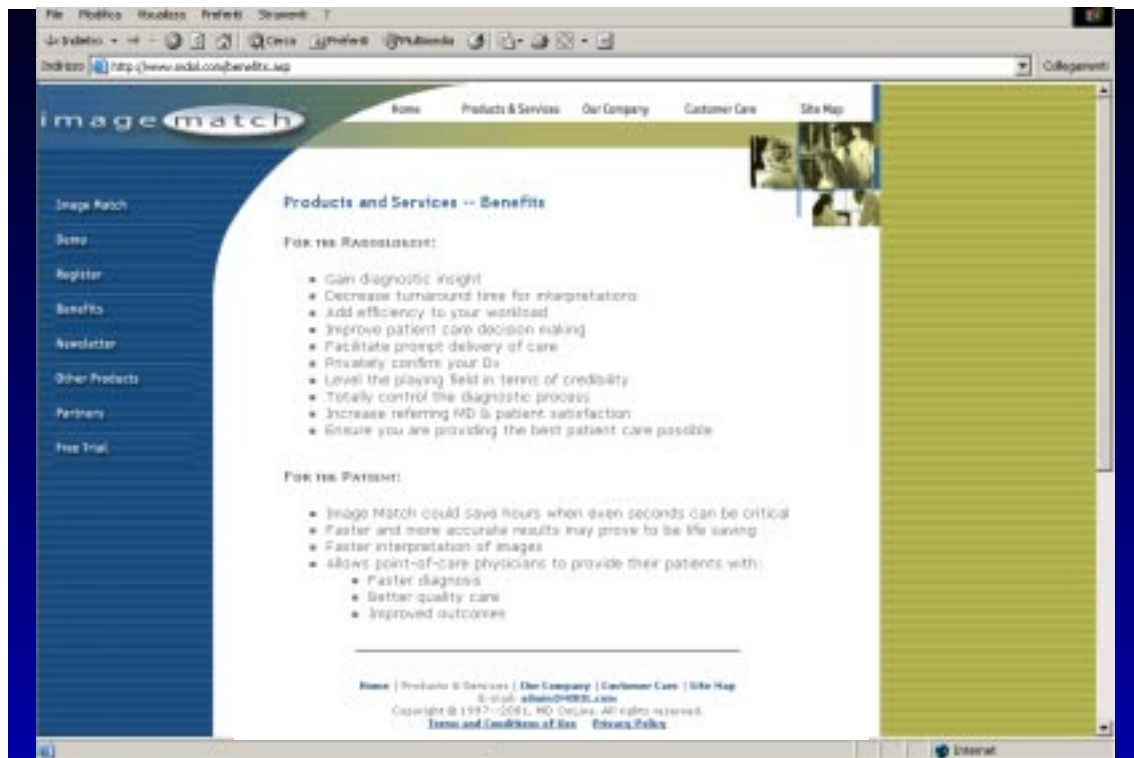
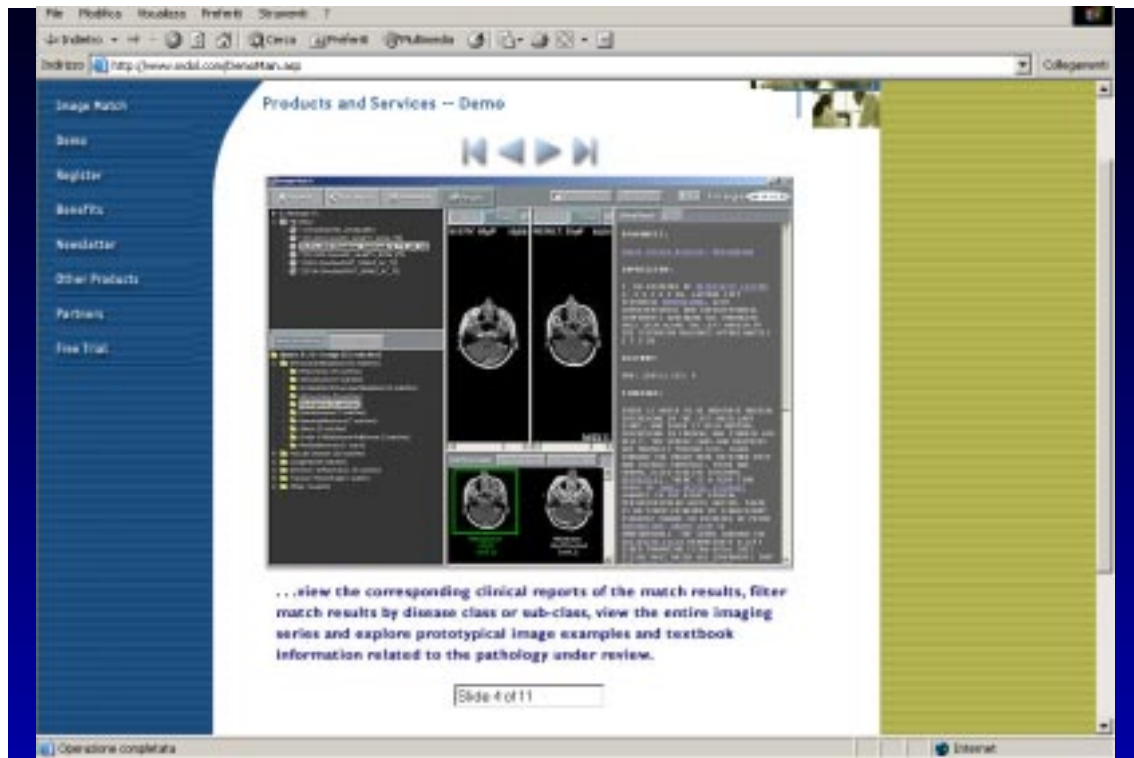


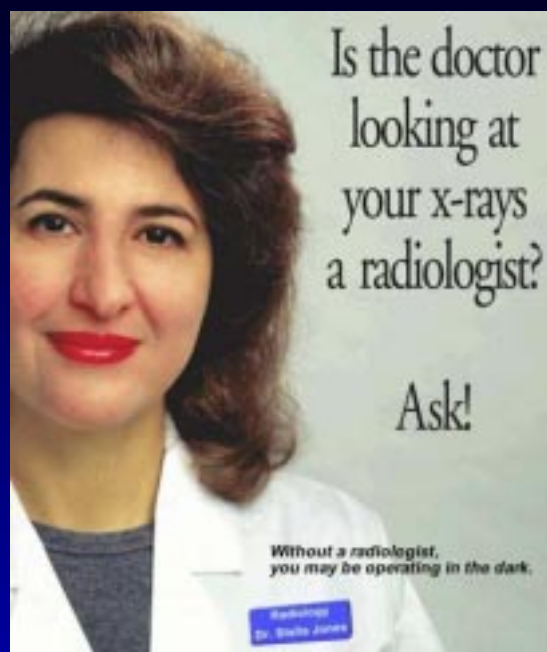
What is the role of Eurad Consult?

- **For expert opinions:** our company has an intermediary role between the customer, who provides us with medical images, and the expert, who will give his advice. We take care of all logistics, such as reception and return of the images, and preparation and (in most cases) digitisation of the films for transmission. We will select the most appropriate expert and personally communicate all relevant medical information to him/her for each case. Eurad Consult does all follow-ups until the customer has received his report (see flow chart). In addition, all files are backed-up and stored. As an option the customers can also obtain their records on CD-ROM. As for our second opinion services we can also make appointments for additional imaging studies if necessary, for example a case needs to be "consolidated".
- **For primary readings:** we can report all types of radiology studies. Our radiologists are fully trained in all imaging techniques. Speed of delivery of reports can be discussed depending on the client's needs. Subspecialty radiologists are readily available for supervision of difficult studies.
- **For patients:** Teleradiology and telemedicine opinions may prevent unnecessary foreign travel by the patient to a centre of excellence in order to obtain a second opinion. Often, a diagnosis that has been made in the original country can be validated by one of our subspecialty experts, thereby reassuring both the local physician and the patient.
